CEVITAL APPOINTS WILMAR AS EXCLUSIVE RAW SUGAR SUPPLIER

Singapore, August 29, 2013 - Cevital Spa ("Cevital") and Wilmar Sugar Pte Ltd ("Wilmar Sugar"), a subsidiary of Wilmar International Limited, are pleased to announce the appointment by Cevital of Wilmar Sugar as its exclusive agent and authorised operator for the supply of raw sugar to Cevital's two refineries in Bejaia, Algeria, starting from 1 September 2013.

The parties have agreed to pool their resources and purchasing power in the raw sugar market in order to improve profitability and synergy between the two Groups.

Cevital is one of the largest sugar refineries in the world, with a combined annual refining volume of about 1.5 million metric tonnes ("MT") from its two refineries in Bejaia. Wilmar Sugar manages an annual refining capacity of about 3 million MT from the Wilmar Group's sugar refineries located in Indonesia, Australia, New Zealand and its associate, Cosumar S.A.'s refinery in Morocco.

About Cevital

Cevital is an Algerian company specialised in the Food industry. It was created by Issad Rebrab in 1998. It is at the moment the 2nd biggest Algerian company in terms of turnover. The food processing industrial complex Cevital established near the port of Bejaïa is the biggest private complex in Algeria. It is composed of three manufacturing units:

- The oil refinery with an output of 1,800 tonnes/day
- The sugar refinery with an output of 4,100 tonnes/day
- Margarinery and vegetable oils with an output of 600 tonnes/day

Cevital also has cereal, white sugar, and brown sugar harbour silos with a capacity of 182,000 tonnes.
