Tong Hai was with IBM from 1988 to 1999, first as a Business and Programmer Analyst and then rising to become the Internet & E-Commerce Regional Manager of IBM Asia Pacific. During this period, he

was also the General Manager of International Application Solutions, a subsidiary of IBM Singapore.

An Honours graduate in Electrical Engineering from the National University of Singapore, Tong Hai is 45 years old and is married with two children.
