Studio City Casts a Global Entertainment Spotlight on Macau Hollywood Legends Scorsese, De Niro and DiCaprio Celebrate Historic Collaboration in "The Audition" at the Spectacular Studio City Opening

Iconic Stars of Studio City's Short Film – First Hollywood Production Tribute to Macau

Macau – October 27, 2015 – Studio City, the thrilling new Hollywood-inspired, cinematically themed entertainment and leisure destination, came under the global spotlight today when Hollywood legends Robert De Niro, Leonardo DiCaprio, Academy award-winning director Martin Scorsese and acclaimed director and producer Brett Ratner, made an unprecedented appearance in Macau, revealing their historic collaboration of '*The Audition*' - the first Hollywood production tailor-made for Macau.

The Studio City inspired short film marks the first time that the three screen giants have collaborated on a film production. It also heralds a new landmark for world-leading, innovative, leisure destination focused entertainment in Macau and Asia.

Presented by Melco Crown Entertainment ("MCE") and RatPac Entertainment, "The Audition" premiere sets the stage for the grand launch of the highly-anticipated and glamorous US\$3.2 billion integrated resort, Studio City. The high-profile short film is helmed by Academy Award-winning director Mr. Scorsese and depicts mega-stars Robert De Niro, Leonardo DiCaprio, and Brad Pitt playing themselves as they vie for the same part in a fictitious movie.

"The Audition" has been produced by acclaimed Hollywood director and producer Brett Ratner, with MCE's Co-Chairman and Chief Executive Officer, Mr. Lawrence Ho, and Co-Chairman, Mr. James Packer, serving as Executive Producers.

Home to a world of 'firsts' in best-in-class entertainment attractions, Studio City, together with the historic Hollywood short film is the realization of Melco Crown Entertainment's vision to establish Studio City as Asia's Entertainment Capital, delivering highly innovative entertainment offerings to support Macau's development into a world-leading leisure and tourism destination.

"When we first envisioned building a cinematically-themed integrated resort in Macau, we wanted to bring the best of the best of entertainment to the world," explained **Mr. Lawrence Ho, Co-Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Melco Crown Entertainment.**

Studio City's official opening represents a key milestone in our strategy to develop Macau as a truly world-leading tourism and entertainment destination, I am extraordinarily proud of what we have achieved here."

Acclaimed Hollywood producer and director Mr. Brett Ratner commented: "This incredible and unprecedented collaboration is a perfect union between the arts and commerce, resulting in a breakthrough piece of film. It truly sets the stage for the ground-breaking, world-class entertainment offerings at this incredible, cinematically-themed resort."

Academy Award-winning director Martin Scorsese said: "We all loved making *The Audition*. It was great to have the new Studio City in Macau as our setting, because it has the feeling of the most fantastic Hollywood set ever designed. You can feel the love of movies and movie history there—in fact, I felt it at every stage of this project, starting with my discussions with Lawrence Ho and James Packer and their team. Working with my old friends Robert De Niro and Leonardo DiCaprio again, with Brad Pitt for the first time, all on one project—there was a tremendous creative energy and humor that was infectious. We were given the creative freedom that we needed, and the trust. Altogether, it was a wonderful experience."

Academy Award-winning actor Robert De Niro shared his excitement at being part of the opening of the cinematically-inspired leisure and entertainment destination: "It's an honor to be working with Martin Scorsese once again. I am delighted to be part of *'The Audition'* and to celebrate the inauguration of Studio City. It is a 'must-see' destination for all visitors looking for a unique and immersive experience."

The World Premiere of "The Audition" was screened as part of a series of events celebrating the Grand Opening of Studio City. From late evening today, Studio City will be publicly airing its 16-minute Hollywood short film 'The Audition', transporting all Macau visitors into a truly Hollywood world with Studio City's one-of-a-kind entertainment offerings.

The Hollywood-themed studio-concept resort is a thrilling new cinematic inspired entertainment and leisure destination and is designed to be the most diversified entertainment offering in Macau. Ideally located on Cotai, close to the Lotus Bridge immigration point connecting Hengqin Island and a future station-point for the Macau Light Rapid Transit, Studio City will deliver more world-class entertainment amenities than any integrated resort in the market.

Studio City's stunning Art Deco facade includes the "Golden Reel", the world's highest figure-8 Ferris wheel which straddles the resort's two-tower hotel at a height of some 130 meters.
