Traffic Statistics – February 2012

Dublin & London, 6 March 2012: Aer Lingus Group plc ("Aer Lingus"), today announced traffic statistics for the month of February 2012.

Total flown passenger numbers, including Aer Lingus Regional operations, increased by 8.8% in February 2012. Aer Lingus' total flown passenger numbers, in February 2012 were 599,000, an increase of 7.5% compared to February 2011. Short haul flown passengers in February 2012 were 554,000, an increase of 6.9% on February 2011, while long haul flown passengers in February 2012 were 45,000, an increase of 15.4% on February 2011.

Aer Lingus' flown passenger load factor in February 2012 increased by 1.0 point on February 2011 to 67.3%. Short haul flown load factor was 68.5%, an increase of 0.6 points on February 2011, with capacity increasing by 5.9%. Long haul flown load factor was 64.9%, an increase of 2.2 points on February 2011, with capacity increasing by 11.4% on February 2011.

Aer Lingus Regional's total flown passenger numbers in February 2012 were 59,000, an increase of 22.9% compared to February 2011.
