Traffic Statistics – December 2009

Dublin & London, 8 January 2010: Aer Lingus Group plc ("Aer Lingus"), today announced traffic statistics for the month of December 2009.

Aer Lingus' total passenger numbers in December 2009 were 766,000 an increase of 9.0% compared to December 2008. Short haul passengers were 693,000, a 13.2% increase on December 2008 and long haul passengers were 73,000, a 19.8% decrease on December 2008.

Aer Lingus' overall load factor in the month was 71.9%, an increase of 2.5 points compared to December 2008, with capacity decreasing by 4.9%. Short haul load factor was 69.5%, an increase of 2.6 points on 2008, with capacity increasing by 11.6%. Long haul load factor was 76.8%, an increase of 4.2 points on 2008, with capacity decreasing by 26.4%.
