Traffic Statistics – March, 2008

Scheduled passengers increased by 15.4% on March 2007

Dublin & London, 7 April 2008: Aer Lingus Group plc ("Aer Lingus"), today announced traffic statistics for the month of March 2008.

Aer Lingus' total passenger numbers grew by 15.4% in March 2008 on the same period in 2007. This comprises of a 15.7% increase in passenger numbers on short-haul and a 13.4% increase on long haul.

The March load factor on short haul performed strongly, increasing to 78% from 76.9% in 2007, despite a 22.6% increase in capacity for the same period.

Long-haul load factor was down to 72.2% for March with capacity for the month increasing by 31.5%. This capacity increase reflects the introduction of the two new long haul aircraft and the launch of three new routes under Open Skies in the second half of 2007.
