

GRAVITY PICTURES' THE ADVENTURERS TO BE RELEASED IN IMAX® THEATRES ACROSS CHINA

SHANGHAI – July 25, 2017 – IMAX Corporation (NYSE:IMAX) and IMAX China Holding, Inc. (HKSE: 1970) today announced that Gravity Pictures' much-anticipated action-packed adventure film, *The Adventurers*, will be digitally re-mastered in the immersive IMAX format and released in approximately 420 IMAX[®] theatres in China, beginning Aug. 11.

The Adventurers follows an infamous thief, played by Andy Lau, on jewel heist that takes him throughout Europe, under the watchful eyes of a French detective, played by Jean Reno. The film marks the first Chinese local-language IMAX DMR title released with Gravity Pictures and the third with director Stephen Fung, which included *Tai Chi O* and *Tai Chi Hero* in 2012.

The IMAX release of *The Adventurers* will be digitally re-mastered into the image and sound quality of The IMAX Experience[®] with proprietary IMAX DMR[®] (Digital Re-mastering) technology. The crystal-clear images, coupled with IMAX's customized theatre geometry and powerful digital audio, create a unique environment that will make audiences feel as if they are in the movie.
