HP Investor Relations Updates

HP Acquires Cloud Software Provider Eucalyptus

Last week, [HP announced](#) a definitive agreement to acquire Eucalyptus, a provider of open source software for building private and hybrid enterprise clouds. After the transaction closes, Eucalyptus CEO Marten Mickos, a respected leader in the cloud industry and a longtime advocate of open source, will join HP to run the Cloud business, reporting to Meg Whitman. This transaction will

strengthen and accelerate the strategy HP has had in place for more than three years, which is to help businesses build, consume and manage open source hybrid clouds. Read a Q&A with Mickos on [HP Next](#).

HP Reports Q3 Earnings

On August 20th, HP reported [Q3 earnings](#). HP achieved an important milestone in the fiscal 2014 third quarter – for the first time in three years, we delivered top line revenue growth on a year-over-year basis. Performance was driven by very strong revenue growth in Personal Systems, as well as growth in Industry Standard Servers and Networking. Performance in Printing, Enterprise Services and Software was mixed with good profitability but weaker top line results. While turnarounds are not linear and we face some tough comparisons in the fourth quarter, these results demonstrate the real progress HP is making.

Martin Fink at the Citi Global Technology Conference 2014

Innovation is alive and well at HP, and we continue to invest in R&D in HP Labs and across the businesses for future product innovations. On September 2nd, Martin Fink spoke at the Citi Global Technology Conference, where he discussed HP's R&D focus areas, including the HP Helion cloud portfolio, Moonshot, 3D printing and The Machine. HP Unveils New ProLiant Gen9 Servers

In August, we announced a new portfolio of [HP ProLiant Generation 9 \(Gen9\) Servers](#). This new offering will help customers reduce cost and complexity, accelerate IT service delivery and enable business growth. The new portfolio is a milestone in HP's compute strategy, which addresses IT demands with a vast pool of processing resources that can be located anywhere, scaled to any workload and available at all times.

HP Helion Momentum

As you saw from the Eucalyptus acquisition, this is an exciting time for HP's cloud business. Since launching the HP Helion portfolio and the HP Helion Network this year, we announced [HP Helion](#)

[OpenStack® Professional Services](#) to help enterprises implement OpenStack technology-based clouds. We also [recently announced](#) an agreement to build and operate community clouds for enterprise customers in China, one of the fastest growing cloud markets in the world. And the industry is taking notice – HP is growing share in private cloud and we are the leader in the Forrester Wave report for Private Cloud Solutions¹.

HP Enterprise Services Customer Wins

As Meg said during our Q3 earnings call, HP's Enterprise Services business is making progress on aligning its sales engine and we are seeing bookings growth in new logos. Recent customer wins include a [\\$147 million Medicaid contract extension](#) with the state of Delaware; an extended [hardware and services agreement with Shell](#) to deliver more than 150,000 products and IT integration and support services; a [contract extension with Trilux](#), Germany's leading lighting manufacturer, to operate all of the company's SAP® systems; and a [\\$55.8 million agreement](#) to continue managing the city of Anaheim's IT environment.

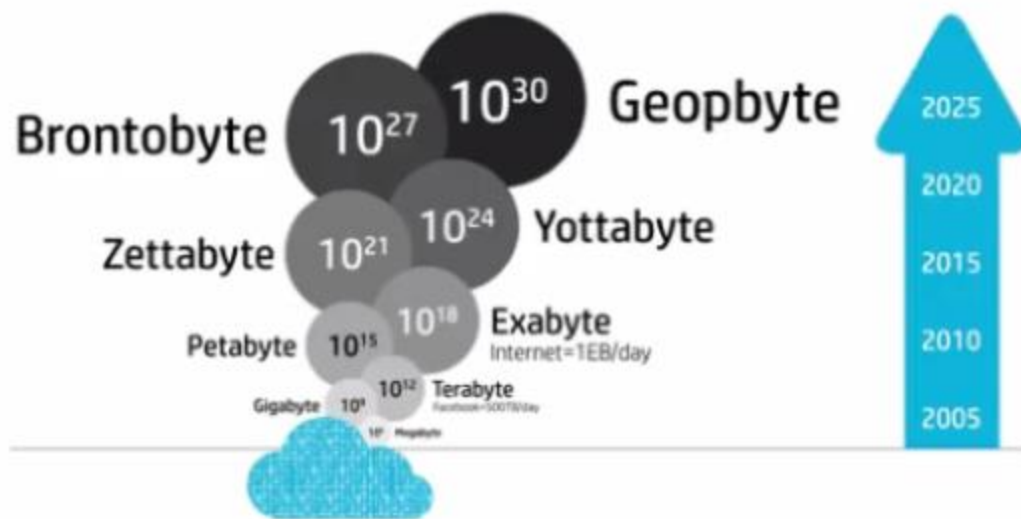
HP Unveils New Storage Offerings


