- **PWRLink® II PWL42XX DFB Transmitter** – low cost transmitters in multiple output powers that enable an operator to pay only for power level required, while delivering lower energy consumption. The transmitters feature broadcast and narrowcast inputs, extending the existing fiber reach up to 45 km

With dynamic backplates, both transmitters are easy to service and install.
