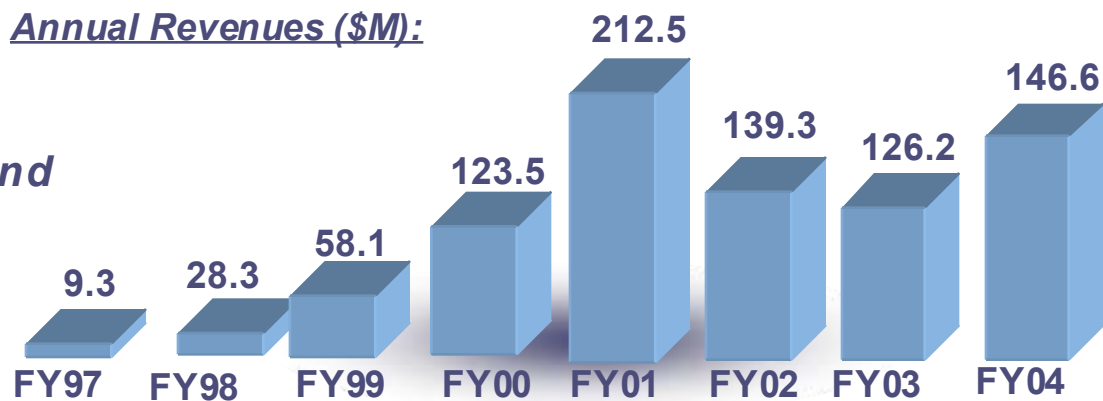

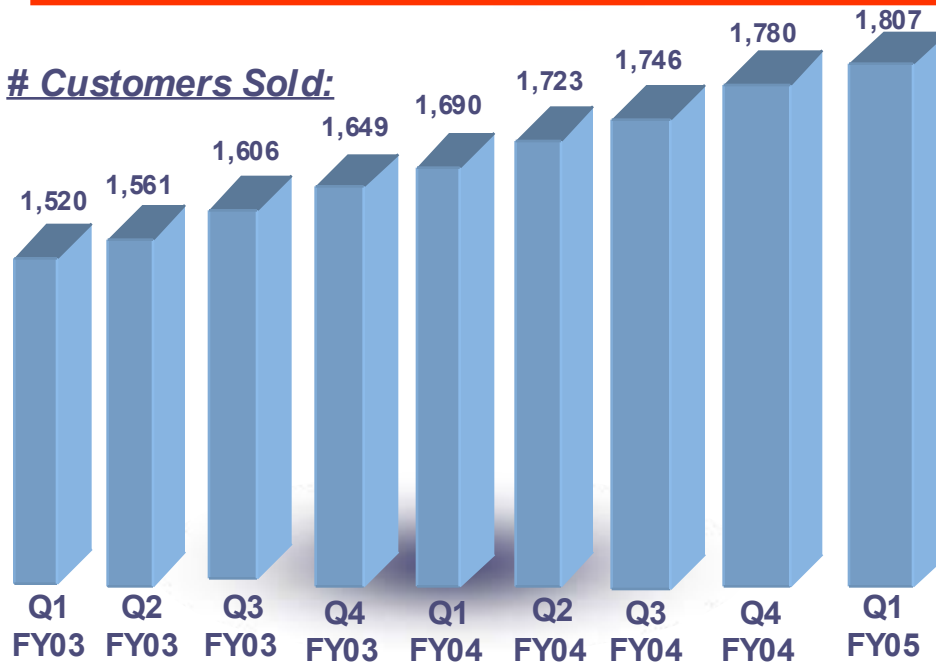

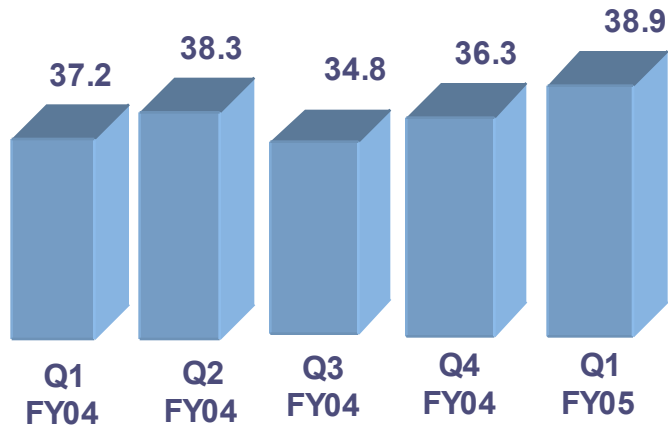
Q1 FY 2005 Business Performance



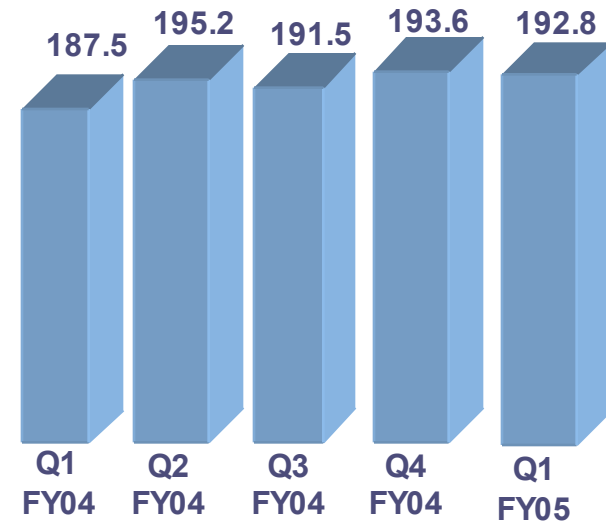

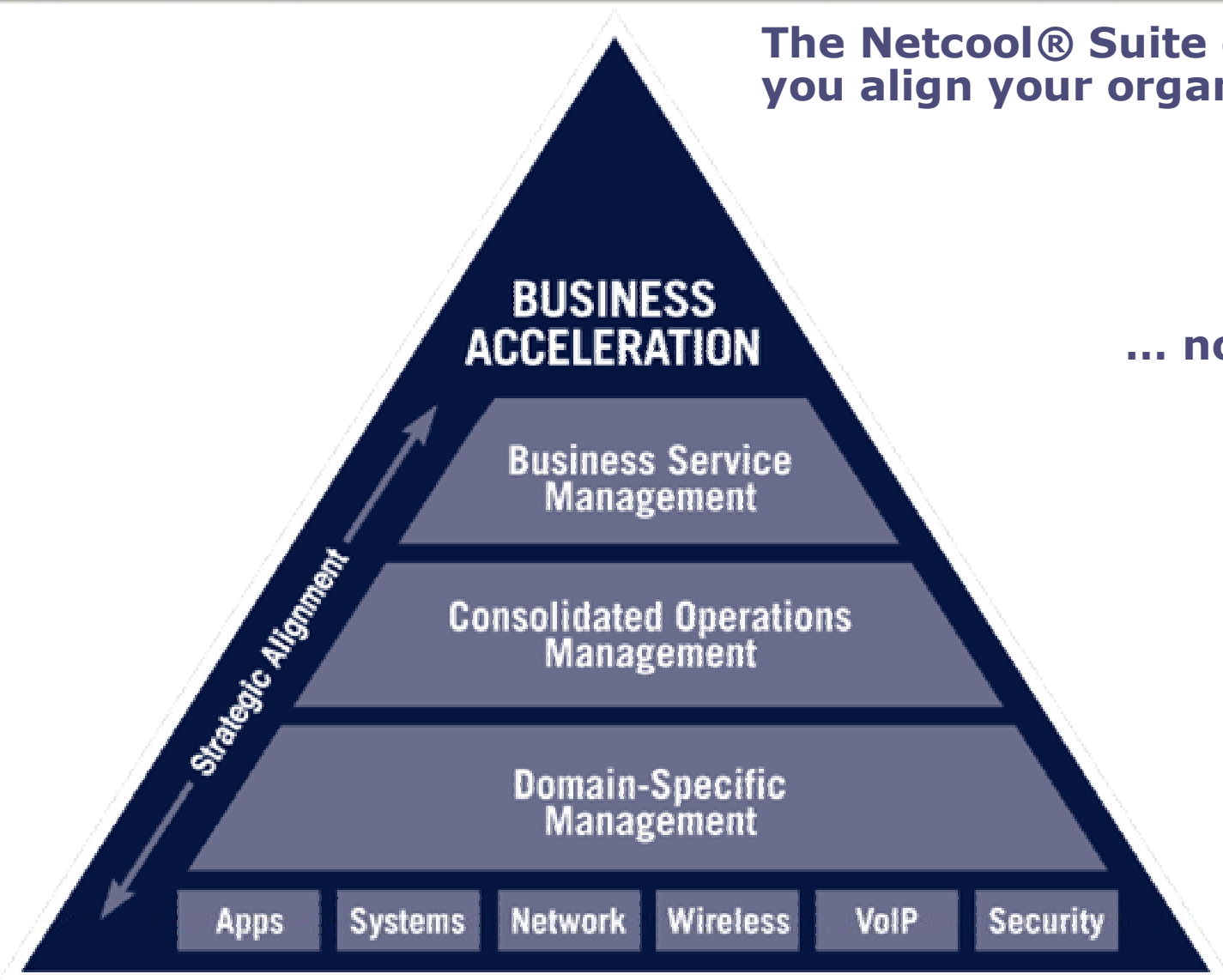
