ZixCorp's easy-to-use service connects entities with their customers and partners to protect and deliver sensitive information in healthcare, finance, insurance and government.

ZixVPM® is a policy-based email encryption gateway for privacy and compliance.

ZixDirectory™ is the largest email encryption directory in the world, protecting more than 7.5 million email addresses.

ZixConnect™ allows customers to securely communicate with their regulators and partners without the need for additional hardware or software at their facility.

ZixDirect™ uses clientless "push" technology that sends encrypted messages directly to the recipient's inbox.

ZixPort® uses clientless "pull" technology that sends encrypted email through a web portal.

PocketScript delivers end-to-end connectivity within the healthcare system to reduce unnecessary costs, improve patient safety and convenience, and enhance practice efficiency. PocketScript enables physicians to order prescriptions through a secure wireless mobile PDA or secure Web site and deliver them electronically to retail pharmacies via SureScripts or mail order pharmacies via RxHub. The application also provides comprehensive drug-to-drug and drug-to-allergy interaction alerts based on patient-specific dispensed drug history.

2006 Business Highlights

- 2006 Company-wide revenues were a record \$18.4 million, an increase of 41% over 2005
 - Email Encryption revenues were \$14.1 million, a 41% increase over 2005
 - e-Prescribing revenues were \$4.3 million, a 43% increase over 2005
- Both businesses are subscription-based with primarily fixed costs
- Company-wide backlog was a record \$26.5 million as of December 31, 2006
- December 31, 2006 ending cash balance was \$12.8 million, ahead of guidance
- Projected cash burn will be at most \$4.8 million in 2007 before ZixCorp turns cash flow positive in 2008
- For its Email Encryption business, ZixCorp had \$17.5 million in new orders in 2006 and maintained a renewal rate of 95% for its eligible customer contracts
- For its e-Prescribing business, ZixCorp deployed over 2,250 new prescribers in 2006. As of December 31, 2006, there were approximately 2,800 active users of ZixCorp's PocketScript solution. There were 5.3 million total e-scripts processed in 2006
