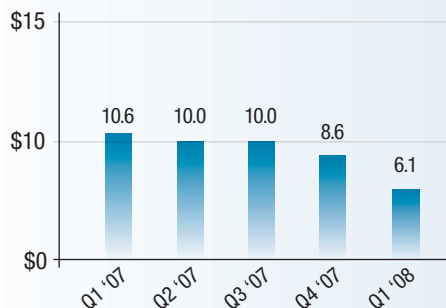


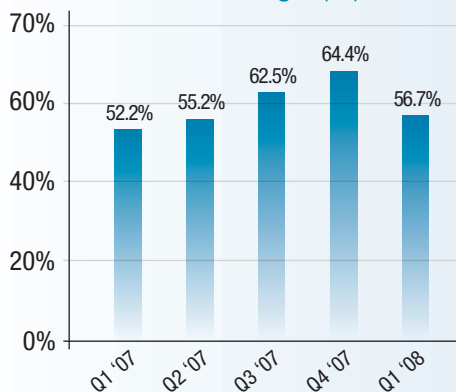

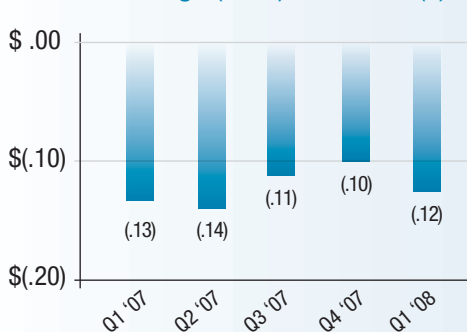
Revenues (\$M)
