NRG Raises More than \$120,000 for the Mercer Street Friends Food Bank

-Annual Fundraising Event Brings Employees, Family and Friends Together to Fight Hunger in NJ-

PRINCETON, NJ; October 1, 2008 — In New Jersey, nearly 750,000 residents live in households earning less than the federal poverty level. Stagnant wages, along with rising costs for healthcare, gasoline, housing and groceries, are making it increasingly difficult for some less fortunate families to buy food.

NRG Energy, Inc. (NYSE: NRG), a Princeton-based wholesale energy provider, recently held its annual picnic and charity fundraiser to address this year-round concern. Through silent and live auctions and a raffle, NRG's employees raised \$60,000 for Mercer Street Friends Food Bank, a regional food bank that helps families who reside in Mercer County. Additionally, NRG Global Giving matched the contribution dollar for dollar, and will present \$120,000 to the food bank.
