NZOG'S TIEKE-1 DRILLING UPDATE

New Zealand Oil & Gas Ltd ("NZOG") reports that at 0600 hours today, the Tieke-1 well was cementing 13-3/8" casing at a measured depth of 1,495 metres. During the week, 17-1/2" hole was drilled from 229 metres to 1,495 metres. Progress for the week was 1,266 metres.

Tieke-1 is located in PMP 38158, 40 km off the west coast of New Zealand's North Island and approximately 8 km from the Tui oil field (see figure 1). The well is being drilled to a planned total depth of 3,600 metres, in a water depth of 122 metres.

Following completion of operations at Tieke-1, the offshore drilling rig will commence the development drilling activities on the adjacent Tui Area Development.
