



Liberty Global Announces New Structure Of European Technology Team

Denver, Colorado/Amsterdam, the Netherlands – September 9, 2005: Liberty Global, Inc. (“Liberty Global”) (NASDAQ: LBTYA, LBTYB, LBTYK), announced today a new structure for its European technology team, headed by Tony Werner, Chief Technology Officer (CTO) of Liberty Global, effective October 3, 2005. These changes follow the retirement of Sudhir Ispahani, Chief Technology Officer (CTO) of Liberty Global Europe who will be leaving the company. Sudhir has served as CTO of Liberty Global Europe and its predecessor companies, UGC Europe, UPC and chello broadband since 1998.

Eric Lennon, currently Managing Director of Digital Architecture, has been appointed as CTO of UPC Broadband, Liberty Global’s European distribution operation. In this role he will be reporting to Gene Musselman, President and Chief Operating Officer of UPC Broadband on an operational basis, and directed by Tony Werner for functional and strategic issues. Eric will assume responsibilities for the UPC Broadband Digital Network Architecture, IP and HFC Architecture, Integrated Labs and Testing and Technical Finance and Capacity Planning.

Eric and several of his team members will also be working with Tony on Global Technology Strategies. Bonnie Gray, currently Managing Director Field Operations, will assume the title of Chief Network Operations for UPC Broadband, including Engineering, Program Management and Field Operations and continue to report to Gene Musselman.

Mehrdad Mansourpour has recently joined UPC Broadband to become the new Chief Information Officer of UPC Broadband, overseeing the company’s IT systems, reporting to Gene Musselman. Mehrdad brings many years of experience in IT lastly as Chief Information Officer at Flag Telecom Group Ltd. He succeeds Sue Whitehead who has decided to move back to the US with her family.

Sudhir Ispahani said: "Over the last seven years it has been my privilege to serve as CTO and Chairman of the Technology Board of the Liberty Global Europe group of companies. During this time and with the hard work of many dedicated managers and employees Liberty Global Europe has established a leadership position in the development and deployment of IP and digital broadband services across Europe. Going forward I am confident that under Tony Werner’s leadership the momentum we have established will continue and Tony will build on the strong technology foundations that have been established."

The former UGC Technology Board will transform into the Liberty Global Technology Board, which will be chaired by Tony Werner.

Tony Werner said: “I would like to personally and professionally thank Sudhir for all of his contributions to the company. He and his team have made tremendous progress in establishing one of the most advanced digital broadband networks in the world. Sudhir is leaving behind a significant legacy at Liberty Global, not to mention his involvement and leadership throughout Europe. Sudhir has played a key role on behalf of the cable industry and as chairman of EuroCableLabs and in the development of technology standards that have enabled the rapid deployment of IP and digital services throughout Europe.”

Liberty Global owns interests in broadband distribution and content companies operating outside the continental United States, principally in Europe, Asia, and the Americas. Through its subsidiaries and affiliates, Liberty Global is the largest broadband cable operator outside the U.S. in terms of subscribers.
