Gil Cloyd assumed the role of Procter & Gamble's Chief Technology Officer on July 1, 2000 after 26 years with the company.

Mr. Cloyd attended Ohio State University where he received a degree in Veterinary Medicine (D.V.M 1969) and Veterinary Pathology (1971). He was a small animal practitioner and consultant for P&G two years prior to being hired in 1974 as a Staff Veterinarian at the Miami Valley Innovation Center in Ross, Ohio. His initial assignment was in the Corporate Professional & Regulatory Services Division as supervisor of the Hematology and Clinical Chemistry Laboratory.

Over the next 10 years, Mr. Cloyd held a variety of positions of increasing responsibility in Professional & Regulatory Services and Human & Environmental Safety. He then moved to Pharmaceuticals at P&G's Norwich facility in New York in 1984, becoming Vice-President of Pharmaceuticals in 1991. In a unique dual role, as head of R&D and General Manager of Pharmaceuticals, he set the strategy and plans that allowed P&G to evolve into a profitable Rx business with an excellent pipeline.

Prior to becoming Chief Technology Officer, Gil was located in Kobe, Japan with responsibility for Corporate R&D-Asia and global Adult Incontinence. During his tenure there, he helped lead the turnaround of the Japanese business behind superior products.
