New World Resources N.V. (“NWR” or the “Company”), a coal and coke holding company that is the sole shareholder of OKD, a.s., the Czech Republic’s largest hard coal mining company, announced yesterday the pricing of the Offer of its existing and new ordinary A Shares at £13.25 per ordinary A Share at the top of the indicative Price Range of £10.75 to £13.25 per ordinary A Share.

A total of 83,013,344 ordinary A Shares, consisting of 13,500,000 new A Shares and 69,513,344 existing A Shares sold by RPI Industries SE, the Company’s sole shareholder, have been sold in the Base Offer, which represents 31.5% of NWR’s issued A Share capital. The Base Offer excludes A Shares subject to an over-allotment option which may amount up to an additional 12,452,001 secondary shares or 15% of the total A Shares sold in the Base Offer.

The funding and settlement of the Offer is expected to commence on 9 May 2008.
