AIG TO REPORT THIRD QUARTER 2006 EARNINGS AND HOLD CONFERENCE CALL

NEW YORK, October 26, 2006 – American International Group, Inc. (AIG) will report its third quarter 2006 earnings on Thursday, November 9, 2006, after the close of the market.
