(1) Starbucks entered into a joint-venture with Marinopolus in July 2003 in Austria & Switzerland. Starbucks originally entered these markets in 2001 with a sub-20% equity interest with the Bon Appetit Group

(2) Starbucks acquired a 50% equity interest in July 2003 in the Taiwan & Shanghai markets, up from an original sub-20% interest.

(3) Each of Starbucks and Sazaby sold approximately 10% of Starbucks Japan during its IPO in 2001. Starbucks originally had a 50% equity interest.

(4) Starbucks acquired a 50% equity interest in December 2000 in S. Korea, up from an original 100% licensing agreement.

(5) Starbucks acquired a 49.9% equity interest in Malaysia in July 2004.

(6) Starbucks acquired a 50% equity interest in July 2003 in Spain, up from an original sub-20% equity interest.

(7) Starbucks acquired 100% equity interest in February 2002 in Australia.

(8) Starbucks acquired 100% of the Singapore market in July 2004.

(9) Starbucks acquired 100% equity interest in June 2000 in Thailand, up from an original 100% licensing agreement.

(10) Starbucks acquired Seattle Coffee Company (UK) in May of 1998. The Manchester store was the first additional Starbucks store opened after the acquisition.

(11) Starbucks acquired 100% equity interest in Germany in November 2004, up from an original 18% interest.

(12) Starbucks acquired 70% equity interest in Southern China in May 2007, up from 51% in July 2005 (with an original sub-20% equity interest).

(13) The ownership of operations in Chile was restructured from a company-operated market to a joint venture market with our partner, Alsea S.A. de C.V.

Starbucks acquired 100% equity interest in Chile in July 2005, up from an original sub-20% equity interest.

(14) The Middle East license agreement covers 7 countries: Kuwait, Bahrain, Lebanon, UAE, Saudi Arabia, Oman and Qatar.

(15) Starbucks Corporation's Canadian assets were transferred to Starbucks Coffee Canada, Inc. on 12/31/2001.

(16) Puerto Rico is a territory of the U.S.

(17) Starbucks acquired a total of 90% equity interest in October 2006, up from an original 9% equity interest.

(18) Starbucks has entered into licensing agreements to open stores in airports in Amsterdam, the Netherlands, Cork, Ireland and Copenhagen, Denmark.
