Stephen E. Ewing

President and Chief Operating Officer, DTE Energy Gas

Stephen E. Ewing, 57, is president and chief operating officer, DTE Energy Gas, one of three major business units of DTE Energy (NYSE:DTE), a diversified energy company involved in the development and management of energy-related businesses and services nationwide. Ewing is responsible for natural gas distribution and mid-stream operations.

Ewing joins DTE Energy having previously served as president and chief operating officer of MCN Energy Group Inc. and president and chief executive officer of Michigan Consolidated Gas Co. (MichCon), a natural gas utility serving 1.2 million customers in more than 550 communities throughout Michigan. MCN Energy Group is the former parent company of MichCon; when DTE Energy and MCN Energy Group merged in 2001, MichCon became a principal operating subsidiary of DTE Energy.

Ewing joined MichCon in 1971 and held executive positions in the areas of corporate planning, personnel, administration and customer service. In 1985, he was named president and chief operating officer of MichCon, and assumed the role of chief executive officer of MichCon in 1992.

Ewing earned a bachelor of arts degree from DePauw University, and a master's degree in business administration from Michigan State University. He also completed the Harvard Business School's advanced management program. He served four years in the U.S. Air Force, earning the rank of captain before leaving active duty in 1970.

Ewing currently serves on the board of the Interstate Natural Gas Association of America, the Gas Technology Institute, and the American Gas Association. He is the past chairman of the Midwest Gas Association and the Natural Gas Vehicle Coalition.

Ewing also serves on the board of directors of several economic, educational, cultural, community, and health and human service organizations and businesses, including Detroit Regional Chamber, Detroit Economic Growth Corporation, Detroit Zoological Society, AAA Michigan and the Skillman Foundation. He is chairman of the board of trustees of Oakwood Healthcare, Inc. He is a member of the executive board of the Boy Scouts of America's Detroit Area Council, and a member of Leadership Detroit. He is a member of the executive committee of the United Way Community Services Board in Detroit, having also served on the agency's capital fund committee and chairman of its 1997 Torch Drive. Ewing served as a corporate chairman for the 1998 NAACP Freedom Fund Dinner. He also previously served as the chairman of the Metropolitan Affairs Corporation and the Greater Detroit Area Health Council.
