Steven E. Kurmas, 45, is senior vice president, Midstream & Supply, DTE Energy Gas, one of three major business units of DTE Energy (NYSE:DTE), a diversified energy company involved in the development and management of energy-related businesses and services nationwide. Kurmas is responsible for managing MichCon's gas supply as well as operation of the transmission and gas storage system. Additionally, Kurmas has responsibility for all gas engineering and construction, non-utility interstate pipeline and storage development, and oil and gas production.

Kurmas joins DTE Energy having previously served as president and chief executive officer of MCN Midstream & Supply, and senior vice president of MichCon Supply Services, both wholly-owned subsidiaries of MCN Energy Group Inc. When DTE Energy and MCN Energy Group merged in 2001, DTE Energy Gas became one of three major business units of DTE Energy.

Prior to joining MichCon in 1981, Kurmas worked for ANR Pipeline Co. in the engineering group as a senior staff engineer. Kurmas held various positions in MichCon's engineering, construction, production, operations and gas supply areas before being named senior vice president of operations and engineering in 1997.

Kurmas earned a bachelor of science degree in chemical engineering and a master's degree in chemical engineering from Wayne State University.

Kurmas is president elect of the board of directors of the Engineering Society of Detroit. He is a member of the National Society of Professional Engineers and the American Gas Association's operations management committee and leadership council. He formerly served on the board of directors of the Michigan Oil & Gas Association. In 1996, Kurmas was selected by Gas Industries magazine as outstanding gas industry manager of the year.
