Daniel L. Schiffer, 57, is vice president and general counsel at Michigan Consolidated Gas (MichCon), a natural gas utility serving 1.2 million customers in more than 500 communities throughout Michigan. MichCon became a principal operating subsidiary of DTE Energy when MichCon's former parent company, MCN Energy Group, merged in 2001 with DTE Energy, (NYSE:DTE), a diversified energy company involved in the development and management of energy-related businesses and services nationwide.

Schiffer joined MichCon in 1977 as a staff attorney. Schiffer held various positions within the office of general counsel, maintaining a focus on regulatory and corporate law. He was named associate general counsel in 1984, and appointed board secretary of MCN Energy in 1988. Schiffer also served as senior vice president of MCN.

Schiffer earned a bachelor of arts degree in economics from Brooklyn College in New York and a law degree from Cornell University's Law School.

Schiffer is a member of the American Bar Association, Michigan Bar Association, Detroit Bar Association and the Federal Energy Bar Association.
